Treble Clef - Play with your  
right hand

Bass Clef -  
Play with  
your left hand

Slur means to play smoothly

Minim hold for 2 beats

Crotchet hold for  
1 beat

Barline - Separates beats  
into a bar

Whole bar rest -  
Don't play with your left  
hand for a whole bar

## March of the Soldier Ants

Boldly

Quarter rest -  
don't play for 1 beat

Minim - hold for 2 beats

Bracket -  
play with both  
hands on the  
piano

Group of quavers equal 1 beat

Half rest -  
Don't play for 2 beats

Crotchet - hold for 1 beat

# Sharp means to play the note  
next step to the right

F# Semibreve - hold for 4 beats

Slur means to play smoothly
