Study On Black Notes.

All black notes - **b** flat means to play the next note to the left

Time signature - C means common time, another way of saying 4 beats in a bar

Very laid back

Bracket or Brace - Play with both hands

Groups of quavers, play AGMS them quicker than crotchets

Accent means to play harder

Crotchet play for 1 beat

Semibreve means hold for 4 beats

Key signature means all sharps or flats must be played

Treble Clef

Tie means to hold the note down. Don't play the note its joined to

Base clef

Eighth rest - don't play for half a beat

Minim - hold for 2 beats

Double bar line ends the piece
